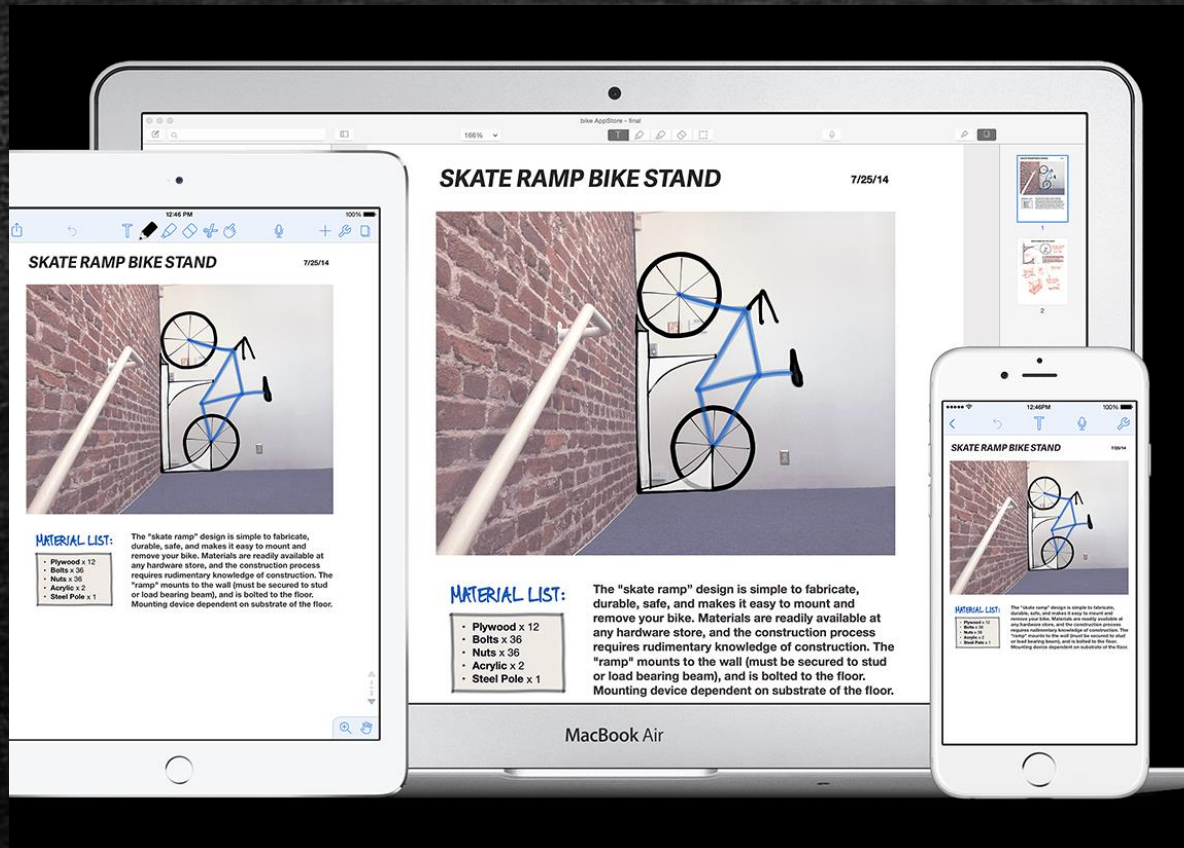
Using Notability

SAMR Model and Notability

- Substitution: Notability is a substitute for traditional note-taking, taking the pen and paper out of the equation.
- Augmentation: Notability also improves on note-taking by allowing notes to be available across multiple devices and gives students the ability to use audio and visual information to add to notes.
- Modification: Traditional note-taking is transformed into a way to keep visual cues, aids, and add to notes. Students are able to share notes with others to collaborate and also annotate PDFs in a digital form.

Notability functions as an improvement on typical note-taking, allowing for handwritten and typed notes to come together. It allows for annotation on other documents and collaboration between others. Notability also offers students a single place to keep notes without an expensive subscription.
